The IBM 3Gb SAS HBA v2 is supported in the following environment:

- Temperature:
 - At 0 1000 m (0 3000 ft): 10 35° C (50 95° F)
 - At 1000 2100 m (3000 7000 ft): 10 32° C (50 90° F)
- Relative humidity: 20 80% (non-condensing)

Warranty

The IBM 3Gb SAS HBA v2 has a one-year limited warranty. When installed on a System x server, these cards assume your system's base warranty and any IBM ServicePac upgrade.

^{*} The 3Gb SAS HBA v2 supports RAID, but only on the System x3455 (RAID levels 0, 1, and 1E are supported). All other supported systems support tape connectivity only. See the announcement letter (link below) for details.
